**Black or African American (not Hispanic or Latino).** A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa. **Hispanic or Latino.** A person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander (Not Hispanic or Latino). A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.

White (not Hispanic or Latino). A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.

Two or more races (not Hispanic or Latino). All persons who identify with more than one of the above five races.
